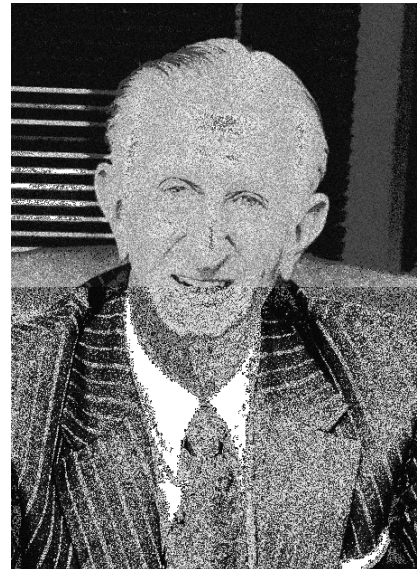

(Knoxville, TN) Dr. Andy Holt is remembered for his inspirational outlook and for the growth of the university under his tenure, a record that included a tripling of student enrollment, a doubling of faculty and staff, and the addition of eight new buildings. In a Brown Bag Lecture on Wednesday, April 12, Dr. Joe Johnson, a close friend and colleague and president emeritus of the University of Tennessee, will discuss Dr. Holt’s career and legacy and the personal characteristics that made him so effective. A video presentation, *Friendly Faces*, will feature excerpts from an interview with Dr. Holt and from one of his most famous speeches.
